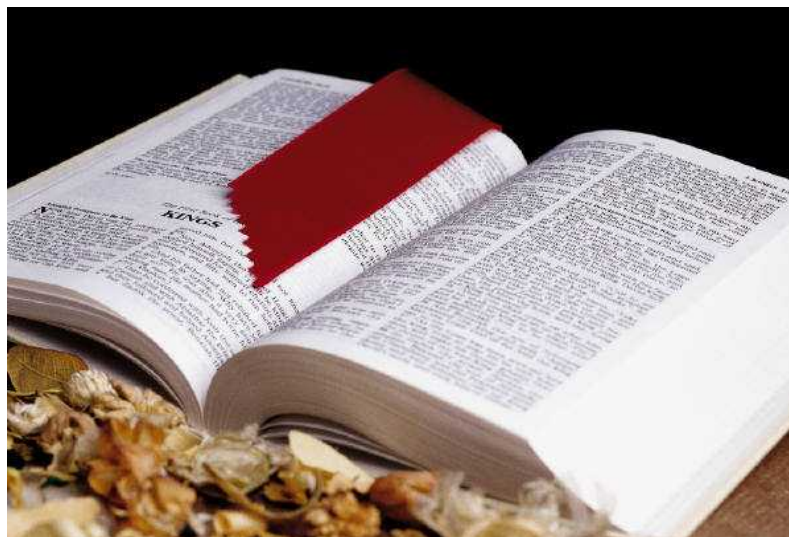

THE HELP MATE

Pro Bono. This term is used in legal matters. The phrase is Latin meaning *"for the public good without compensation"*. Lawyers offer free legal service for people of humble means who otherwise could not afford council. In other words, they take your case and extend to you the best defense possible and provide evidence needed to reduce or extinguish punishment which you may be facing. The nature of the crime is irrelevant. Whether it is a small misdemeanor or a felony charge the lawyer is bound to defend to the best of his ability even though he will not be compensated for his time or effort.

When I mulled over this information I realized how my salvation experience was very similar to that of the "Pro Bono" case.

First of all, I had been charged as a sinner. Although I wasn't at Calvary or witnessed the crucifixion, I was rightfully accused of the death of the Savior. My sin had placed him on his cross. The excruciating pain and suffering he endured was because of me.

The charge that was filed against me required the death sentence as its penalty.

Secondly, I had no means to retain council. No earthly wealth or connections to hire someone who would take my case or advise me.

Finally, a call came which enlightened me. The victim had become my accuser. He was the very person who charged me with his death. But that wasn't all; he was now presenting himself as my Savior the only one who could save me from an eternal death penalty. He had the power to drop the charge, release me and remove the guilt. Best of all there was no fee or retainer to pay. No demands or probation offers were discussed. No plea bargaining or reduction of sentence mentioned. My convicted heart, condemned soul and broken spirit let me know he was my only hope. He would be my advocate. Pleading for his forgiveness which I didn't deserve, begging for mercy which I didn't merit the Savior looked beyond my faults and saw my needs graciously removing the burden of sin. All the charges were dropped. I had been released never to face that accusation again. All this service was offered to me free of charge. My advocate paid the price for me. The best part of all is whenever I call on him he's available any time and any place to council, comfort and forgive me. I'll never have to face the wrath of the Judge because my Savior will plead my case and claim me as his own. There'll be no verdict from a jury, and the Judge will be satisfied, because my advocate, Jesus Christ, is his son. When I couldn't pay the debt he took my case "Pro Bono".
